KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W.A. Bates of the county of Greenville

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of
Ten (\$10.00) Dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by

J. J. Newby,

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. J. Newby his heirs and assigns forever;—All that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Greenville South Carolina, near Marietta; Beginning at a stake, 3 X nm on branch and runs thence S. 40 W., 33.50 to a stone, 3 X nm; thence S. 60 E., 3.00, thence S. 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., 5.00; thence S. 45 E., 6.00; thence S. 50 E., 5.00 to Chestnut 3 X nm; thence N. 43 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., 2.50 to B. gum, 3 X nm on Beaverdam creek; thence N. 30 W., 15.50 to branch; thence with the meanders of said branch to the beginning corner; containing sixty and one-fourth (60 $\frac{1}{4}$) acres more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Hicks Jones by deed dated Oct. 26th, 1909, and recorded in R.M.C. office for Greenville County in Volume 5 page 91. Also all that piece, parcel and tract of land situate in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid containing twenty seven and one-half (27 $\frac{1}{2}$) acres more or less; Beginning at a stake on Pumpkintown Road; thence N. 87 E., 9.00; thence N. 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., 6.00; thence N. 40 E., 3.50; thence N. 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., 7.5 to post oak at fork of Pumpkintown Road and Gap Creek Road; thence with Gap Creek Road N. 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ W., 7.50 to stone in Gap Creek also Mill road; thence with Mill road N. 53 W., 5.00; thence N. 65 W., 4.50; thence N. 87 W., 2.50; thence S. 52 W., 4.90; thence S. 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ W., 6.8 to a stone in Mill Road; thence due South 15.30 to the beginning. Also all that piece, parcel and tract of land, situate in the County and State aforesaid, containing thirty-nine acres (39) being the remaining part of a tract of ninety-nine (99) acres which was conveyed to James J. Wood and W. S. Goot by Gardner Gibbons on 12th April, 1892, but recorded in Book "U U", page 392; W. S. Goot having deeded his interest in said ninety-nine (99) acres to Mrs. Goot, May 30th, 1892, also recorded Book "W W", at page 801; this being the thirty-nine (39) acres remaining after this Goot conveyed sixty and one-fourth (60 $\frac{1}{4}$) acres by said tract to Hicks Jones on 19th Oct., 1904, and recorded in "N N N", 481; and being the same two tracts of land conveyed to me by Nannie J. Goot by deed dated December 22nd, 1909, and recorded in said R.M.C. office in Volume 5, page 624.
