Hobbs - (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

C. O. Hobbs, All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, situate, being and being in the State of South Carolina, in the County and Township of Greenville, a short distance northwest of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 7111 in Block W of Park Place, according to a plat thereof made by C. H.
