is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. G. Edwards all that certain parcel and lot of land, situate and being  
in the county of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the Town of Greer, on the corner  
of Hubert Street and Street leading from Emma Street by Franklin Mill, said lot  
fronting on North side of Hubert Street and having the following metes and bounds:-  
Beginning at an iron pin at intersection of said streets and thence ninety  
(90) nearly west with Hubert street to an iron pin, (Peaches corner); thence nearly north  
with Peaches line two hundred (200) feet to an iron pin, on McGee's line; thence  
nearly east with McGee's line ninety (90) feet to an iron pin on said street; thence
