

W.R. Smith DEED TO E.W. Smith

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W.R. Smith, of the County of Greenville and

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Fourteen hundred (\$1400.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

E.W. Smith (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said E.W. Smith, all that piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid and adjoins the land of W.H. Greer, H.M. Smith and others and has the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a stone 3XNM on W.H. Greers old line and is the new 3X of H.M. Smith, thence with old line as per calls in old deed of Charles H. Livingston, recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Book U, pages 542 & 543. S. 65 E. 2.75 chs. to stake 3X, thence S. 81 E. 9.50 chains to red-oak 3XOM, thence S. 12 E. 14.00 chs. to red-oak 3XOM; thence N. 80 E. 23.00 chs. to Hickory 3XOM; thence N. 3 W. 28.50 chs. to red-oak 3XOM, thence N. 75 W. 7.50 chs. to stone 3XNM on Old line and 3X of H.M. Smith, thence with H.M. Smiths new line South 7.70 chas. to stone NM, thence S. 73-30 W. 18.40 chs. to stone 3XNM, thence N. 63 W. 10.00 chs. to P.O. 3XNM, thence S. 10 W. 10 chs. to the beginning 3X, and contains seventy-eight (78) acres, be the same more or less.

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TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any-wise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said E.W. Smith, and his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said E.W. Smith, and his

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.

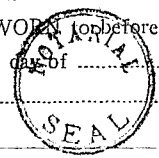
