lying and being in Greer, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the  
south side of Moore Street, and having the following metes and  
bounds: Beginning at corner of lot #17, of the Fannie M. Few property  
at a stake and runs thence S. 12° 58' E. 438.8 feet to a stake or ally, thence with  
said Alley S. 76° 13' W. 60 feet to a stake, corner of lot #15 (Fannie M. Few property),  
thence N. 12° 58' W. 136.7 to a stake on said Moore Street; thence with said Street N. 74° 30' E.
