Burgiss, of the said County and State, parties of the first part, hereinsfter called the grantors, in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) to us in hand paid by Greenville Spartanburg & Anderson Railway Company, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of South Carolina, party of the second part hereinafter called the grantee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; and in further consideration of the prospective advantages and benefits which may accrue to or be derived by the said grantors and their property, and the public, arising from the location, construction and operation of a line of railway through their country or neighborhood, do hereby grant, sell, release and convey unto the said grantee, its successors and assigns, all of the following rights, privileges, and essements, to wit: The right of peaceable, entry, the right of way and easement, at any and all times, for the purpose of surveying, building, constructing, operating, maintaining, improving and repairing a road line or railway to be run by electricity or other motive power, with one or more tracks, upon, along and over all that certain triangular shaped tract of land containing by estimation eightttn one hundredths (18/100) of an acre, situate in the Town of Greer, County and State aforesaid, on the west side of South Main Street, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: BEGINNING at a point on the said street, on the dividing line between Burgiss and Robison, and running thence with said dividing line, N. 54-3/4 W. one hundred and ninety seven (197) feet to a stake; thence S. 78-33 E. one hundred and ninety eight (198) feet to South Main St; thence with said Street, S. 25 W. seventy-nine (79) feet to the point of beginning. As shown on Map M-482 of the Greenville, Spartanburg & Anderson Ry. Company, blue print of which is hereto attached and made a part of this conveyance. Together with the right and privilege upon said right of way, to cut away and keep clear all timber which may endanger the railway or the poles, wires and other appliances, and cut, quarry, dig and take away any stone, wood, gravel, or earth necessary for the construction, operation, and repair of said road or line, and to make all necessary cuts and fills, and to do any and all acts necessary or appropriate for any proper purpose connected with said road or line.
