That E.A. Smythe, the owner of a lot of land on the east side of South Main Street having fifty-one (51) feet front; and S.E. Conyers, the owner of a lot of land on the east side of South Main Street adjoining the above, having a frontage of twenty-five (25) feet on Main Street; and Viola Wickliffe the owner of a lot of land on the east side of South Main Street, adjoining the above named lot of S.E.
