is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Edua Worley, her heirs and assigns, all that tract or lot of land situate in the county aforesaid on the north side of Rutherford Road, about two and three fourths miles from Greenville Court House, beginning at an iron pin corner of F. C. Worley lot, thence N. 30 W. 9.72 to iron pin; thence N. 60 W. one hundred and fifty-one feet to iron pin on Railroad; thence with Railroad S. 30 W. 2.84 to iron pin on railroad; thence S. 33 1/2 E. 9.20 to Rutherford Road; thence with Rutherford Road N. 54 E. 2.45 to beginning corner; also twenty foot road running from railroad across to Rutherford Road, and which is rightly on land of J. S. Plowden and runs just on side of land of J. S. Plowden from the lot, and is the line between the lots of J. S. Plowden and my deed dated the day of January 1907, deed recorded in Vol. 333, at page 367, and contains two and six tenths (2 6/10) acres.
