DEED TO W. D. Parrish et al.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Martin Cotton Oil Company

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina and having its principal place of business at Greenville in the State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS, to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee hereinabove named, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto,

W. D. Parrish and T. G. Gower, all that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, near the City of Greenville, County and state aforesaid and having 1700 following metes and bounds, according to plat of R. E. D. Moore, Engineer, to-wit: Beginning at iron pin on Cedar Lane Road on the Southwest corner of said road and a 30 foot street, and running thence with Cedar Lane Road N. 44° 9' - 10 W. 50.8 ft. to iron pin on the right of way of the P. & N. Ry. siding, thence with said right of way S. 46° 48' V. 114.5 ft. to iron pin, thence still with said right of way S. 43° 47' W. 2.61 ft. to iron pipe in fence of land placed by Martin Cotton Oil Company, thence S. 71° 55' E. 13 ft. to iron pipe on 30 foot street, thence with the western side of said 30 foot street N. 18° 30' E. 316 ft. to point of beginning. This is a portion of the land conveyed to the said corporation by P. J. Martin.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the premises before mentioned unto the grantee hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns forever.

And the said granting corporation does hereby bind itself and its successors to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee hereinabove named, and their heirs and assigns, against itself and its successors, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
