is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

John M. Steele, his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece of land situated lying and being in the City of Greenville County and State above said being Lot No. 1 as laid down on map or plat made by J.W. Southern, S.S., on the 15th day of March 1908, and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in plat Book "A" at page 229 and having a frontage of 26' 6" on Peach Street and a depth of 101' and bounded by lot No. 1, lots of Samuel Peters and Emma Franklin, as will more fully appear by reference to said plat to which reference is made as an exhibit of this description and being the land conveyed to us by D. Brodwater, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County Feb. 10, 1912 Vol. 17, page 376 and on which there are two three story houses. The said John M.
