Greco River and on the Greenville, Spartanburg and Anderson Railway,
improving lands of the Chick Spring Company having the following metes
and bounds viz: Beginning where the Chick Spring Company's line crosses
Creek Creek and running thence down the said Creek back the line to the said
Greco River thence from the said Greco River as the line to the
said Greenville, Spartanburg and Anderson Railway, thence along the said
Railway as the line is there it crosses the Chick Spring Company's
