Wilkins Eagle; All that certain piece or lot of land in the City
of Greenville County and State, aforesaid situated lying and being on the
South side of East Stone Avenue, in the block east of Elizabeth Street,
and known as Lot fifteen as shown by plat recorded by J. N. Southern,
