DEED TO

J. C. Peace

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. P. Ballenger, of Greenville County, in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and Other Valuable Considerations DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. C. Peace,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargain, Sold and Released and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

J. C. Peace, All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the City of Greenville on the East side of Varnoy Street and described as follows: Beginning at a Stake on the East side of Varnoy Street Two Hundred One feet and three inches (201.3) from Cleveland's line, and running thence N. 20° 19' 55" (55) feet with Varnoy Street to a Stake, thence S. 71° 50' E. Two Hundred Seventeen (217) feet to a Stake, thence S. 20° 19' 55" (55) feet to a Stake, thence N. 71° 50' W. Two Hundred Seventeen (217) feet to the beginning corner, and being known as lot No. 39 1/2 Section "H" as shown by plat of Stone Land Company, made by J. C. Scirine, May 2, 1909, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in plat Book 10, page 337-342, and being the same lot conveyed to me by C. W. Fairly his deed dated August 18, 1914, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 2, page 254. Stover to W. A. Wallace Jan. 17th, 1914 to secure the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, said Mortgage recorded in R. M. C. Office for said County in Book 29, page 109. All the above Mortgages bearing interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum.
