E. S. Calhoun, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County  
aforesaid, City of Greenville, in fifth ward, having a frontage of 100 feet on North Street, beginning at a point  
adjoining lands of W. H. Swine and thence 103 feet S. adjoining lands of said W. H. Swine, to a point on W. H. Swine's  
line, thence W. 100 feet with W. H. Swine's line to a point adjoining Phyllis Calhoun's lot, thence 103 feet to North
