 (the receipt whereof is here-

by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said
 J. W. Hickson, all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land containing
 16 1/2 acres, according to a former survey, and being all of that tract or
 parcel of land situated in the State and County aforesaid, on the Waters
 of the Saluda river and Solder Grove creek, described as follows, to wit:
