Charles, all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid on the north side of Fair Bridge Road about ten and one half miles from Greenville Court House and having the following written description and courses and distances to wit: Beginning at a stake 3 x n m in the mouth of a ditch on the north side of the Fair Bridge Road and running thence N. 8 1/2 E. with said ditch 250 feet to a stake 3 x n m in said ditch; thence N. 8 1/2 E. 230 feet to a stake 3 x n m; thence S. 8 1/2 W. 210 feet to a stake, 3 x n m on the said Fair Bridge Road; thence S. 8 1/2 E. 230 feet to the beginning corner, and containing one acre 1/10 acre more or less, and more specifically described in a plot & map made by J.
