by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said L. W. Spann, all those two certain lots of land situated in the County and State aforesaid, near the eastern limits of the City of Greenville, in the vicinity known as Midletown, and being known as lot numbers 38 and 39 of Block "A" of Jefferson Heights as shown by plat of record in the office of R.M.C. for Greenville County in Volume "B" at page 34 and 35, and bearing the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at a pin on the west side of Second Avenue, joint corner of lot no. 37, and running thence S. 81-40 E., eighty-seven feet and five inches to a pin; thence 20-30 E., fifty feet and ten inches to a pin on Second Avenue; thence N. 81-40 E., eighty-seven feet and five inches to a pin on Second Avenue; thence with said Second Avenue, N. 0-30 E., fifty feet and ten inches to the beginning corner, this being the same lot of land conveyed to me by H.B. Grapler and W.S. Bradley by deed bearing date March 2nd 1914, which deed is for record.

by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said William Q. Elision, all that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on the west side of Brandon road at a point recognized as the corner of lands formerly owned by J. H. O'Neal and running thence with said Brandon Road N. 18-45 E., fifty-seven (57) feet, to a stake; thence S. 86 W. for two hundred four (204) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 13-45 W. for sixty-four (64) feet to an iron pin on the line of land formerly owned by J. H.
