COUNTY OF GreenvilleKNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, W.P. Conyers, J.C. Lower and Davis Turner, in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Twenty-Two Hundred and Fifty \$ 00/100 DOLLARS to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G.O. Cureton

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said G.O. Cureton, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, about $3\frac{3}{4}$ miles South west of the City of Greenville on the old Anderson Road and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the Anderson road corner of a tract of thirty acres recently conveyed to H.L. Johnson and running thence to said road S. $65^{\circ} 48' W$, 364 feet and 4 inches to an iron pin in the road; thence with said road S. $73^{\circ} 28' W$, 224 feet to an iron pin on said road corner of the land owned by us; thence S. $27^{\circ} 31' E$, 1468 feet to an iron pin on line of land of W.A. Chandler; thence N. $87^{\circ} 17' E$, 462 feet to an iron pin; thence N. $24^{\circ} 33' E$, 214 feet to an iron pin corner of H.L. Johnson and Smith; thence N. $37^{\circ} 31' E$, 1479 feet to the beginning corner, containing twenty (20) acres more or less and being a part of what is known as the "Nancy McHugh Horse Place."

Berry(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said F.P. Berry, and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in the sixth ward of the City of Greenville, having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on the north side of Sullivan Street S. $88\frac{3}{4} E$, 86 feet, more or less, to the line of lot owned by Goldsmith, thence along his line in a northerly direction to the line of lot formerly belonging to William L. McCrorey; thence along the McCrorey line N. $69 W$, 80 feet, more or less, to line of lot belonging to W.O.
