(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said G. C. Milford, All, That certain parcel or lot of land, situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and in the 6th Ward of the City of Greenville, being all the land that I own on the west side of the branch that crosses Sullivan St. near the Rail Road & runs out through the Mill property, and has the following courses of boundaries:- Beginning at corner of J. W.
