Watson, all that is or parcel of land in Ward Two of Greenville City, said County and State, beginning at the intersection of Brown Street with Coffee Street, as recently established by the City and running thence along the north side of Coffee Street 40 feet, thence by a line parallel with Brown Street 100 feet, thence by a line parallel with Coffee Street 40 feet to Brown Street; thence along Brown Street 100 feet to the beginning corner, being a portion of the land recently conveyed by Alice E. Keenan and others to me.
