by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said William Cox and his heirs and assigns, forever; all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in Ward No. one of the city and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, on Cook and Pine Streets, and having the following recto and levante, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Cook Street, 3x7 Bradley Pickley lot, and running thence with Cook Street S. 3° 45' E. forty-four (44) feet to an iron pin, 3x7 thence N. 87° 15' E. one hundred and fifty-two (152) feet to an iron pin on the West side of Pine Street; thence with Pine Street, N. 2° 45' W. forty-four (44) feet to an iron pin; thence S. 87° 15' W. one hundred and fifty-two (152) feet to the beginning corner, and being part of the land conveyed to me by G.
