Having the following corners - Beginning at a stone 3x on the N.E. corner, thence E. 51° 16' chains to a stone 3x - Thence N. 24° E. 17 1/2 chains to a stone 3x - Thence N. 88° W. 57 1/2 chains to a stone 3x - Thence S. 24° W. 15 1/2 chains to the beginning corner. Bounded by lands of J. S. French, Georgiana Johnson, Hamlett, Ridgeway, and others. Being the same lot of land which was conveyed by H. H. Ridgeway to John M.
