KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Polly Kilgore, of the City and County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) DOLLARS to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. W. Smith,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. W. Smith, and his heirs and assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate on the North side of Lumber Street, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid. Beginning at a point on said Lumber Street one hundred and fifty (150) feet West of Creek Street; thence N. 18 1/2 E., one hundred and thirty-one (131) feet to stake; thence N. 76 3/4 W., fifty-four and one-half (54 1/2) feet to a stake; thence S. 17 W., one hundred and thirty-one (131) feet to Lumber Street; thence with Lumber Street S. 76 3/4 E., fifty and one-half (50 1/2) feet to the beginning corner, containing sixteen one-hundredths (1/100) acre, more or less, and known as lot no. 8 in plet by J.
