by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said E. W. Green, all that piece, parcel and tract of land situate in the State and County aforesaid near the town of Simpsonville containing twelve acres more or less, and lying on both sides of the Old Stage Road, and being all of the fourteen acres of land conveyed us by S. J. Wilson, by his two deeds recorded in the R. M. C's Office in and for Greenville County, in Book V. S. page 591 and 161, 1909, page 553 less however the difference in acreage between tract of land containing 2 1/2 acres more or less, record to S. J. Wilson by deed of March 10th, 1909, recorded in said book, page 591, and a tract of five lots re-purchased by said S. J. Wilson by his deed dated August 14th, 1911, said lots being known as lots 1 to 5 inclusive of Adams survey and having joint outside lines 316 feet by 107 1/4 feet by 290 feet by 128 1/2 feet.
