all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

in the City of Greenville, beginning at a point on an alley one hundred thirty-two and one-tenth feet from the east side of Mulberry Street, this point being the southwest corner of another lot now owned by me, and running thence along said alley in a southeasterly direction seventy-seven and nine-tenths feet to a stake; thence in a line parallel with said Mulberry Street in a northeasterly direction three hundred twenty-four and two-tenths feet to a stake corner of land of W.J. Goodlett; thence with said Goodlett's line in a northwesterly direction seventy and five-tenths feet to a stake; thence in a southwesterly direction three hundred twenty-four and two-tenths feet to the beginning corner.

An alley fifteen feet wide has been laid out along the western side of said lot known as Piedmont Avenue on the map of Greenville, but the same has not been granted to the City nor dedicated to public use and is a private alley for the use of said lot.
