in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bar-

gain, sell and release unto the said John Higdon

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove.

Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Containing fifty-three and one-half acres, more or less, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on a road near the Augusta Road; thence N. 29 E. 1.53 chains to a stone by hickory; thence S. 69 E. 3.60 chains to a stone; thence N. 1 E. 21.35 chains to stone on branch; thence down the meanders of said branch to a stone; thence S. 41 W. 10.25 chains to a dogwood and stone; thence S. 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 15-36 chains to a stone on said road; thence along said road S. 67-3/4 E. 25.75 chains to a stone by a pine at the beginning corner.
