 gain, sell and release unto the said Ben Easley,
 all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
 in the City of Greenville, on the west side of Manley Street: Beginning at an iron pin on Manley Street, one hundred forty-five feet from the northwest corner of Manley and Pettigru Streets, and running thence with said Manley Street N. 16-31 W. seventy feet to iron pin on Jos. A. McCullough's line; thence with his line S. 73-29 W. one hundred feet to an iron pin; thence S. 16-31 E. seventy feet to an iron pin, Cera E. Mason's corner; thence with her line N. 73-29 E. one hundred feet to the beginning corner
