County of Greenville }KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. Jackson Vault

in the State aforesaid  
 in consideration of the sum of  
One Hundred Dollars and other valuable consideration <sup>DOLLARS</sup>  
 to me <sup>in hand paid</sup>  
 at and before the sealing of these presents by R. F. Watson

(the receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said  
R. F. Watson, all those two certain pieces, parcels or tracts of  
 land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina  
 and County of Greenville in Bant Township about six and a  
 half miles from Greenville Court House on the south side of the  
 White Horse Road, about quarter of a mile from the Augusta  
 Road having respectively the following metes and bounds accord-  
 ing to a plat there of made by J. N. Southern bearing date  
 April 14, 1885, to wit: First, that tract beginning at a stone 3x0m  
 on line of land now or formerly belonging to William Myers  
 and running thence along line of the William Abraham land  
 $n 65^{\circ} E 34.33$  chains to red oak 3x0m, thence  $n 37\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} w 9.46$  chs. to a stone  
 3x0m; thence  $n. 61\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E 3.80$  chs. to a pine stump 3x0m in the White  
 Horse Road; thence along said road in a general northwesterly  
 direction  $11.74$  chs. to stone 3x0m, thence  $s 55\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} w 6.00$  chs. to a stone  
 3x0m, on corner of the Pleasant Walker land; thence along  
 line of said land  $s 75\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} w 10.00$  chs. to a stone 3x0m on line  
 of land now or formerly belonging to Bud Ward; thence  
 along line of last mentioned land  $s 2\frac{1}{4}^{\circ} w 24.09$  chs. to the begin-  
 ning corner, containing forty-two (42) acres more or less.  
 A portion of this land having been conveyed to me the said  
 Jackson Vault by deed of George Pickett, executed December  
 18, 1895, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds  
 Conveyances for said County and State on the 21st day  
 of December 1895, in Book "B. C. L." at page 12 and the remaining  
 portion thereof having been conveyed to me by another deed ex-  
 ecuted by the said George Pickett on the 25th day of November  
 1905 and not yet recorded. Second, that tract adjoining the land  
 first above described and having the following metes and  
 bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone 3x0m on corner of the  
 William Abraham land, and running thence  $n 56^{\circ} E$  with  
 line of said Abraham's land 2.35 chains to a stone 3x0m  
 on the White Horse Road; thence along the middle of said road  
 $n 31^{\circ} w 3.13$  chs. to a bend in road; thence along said road  
 $n 21\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} w 6.40$  chs. to a stone 3x0m in said road; thence  
 $s 69^{\circ} w 3.80$  chs. to a stone 3x0m, thence  $s 37\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E 9.80$  chs. to the  
 beginning corner containing three acres more or less  
 and being the first tract of land conveyed to me by the  
 said George Pickett by the unrecorded deed above referred  
 to. There is no mortgage, judgment or other lien or  
 incumbrance on said land except mortgage to  
 Jessie M. Monkley for thirteen hundred dollars, dated  
 May 27, 1916, Recorded in R. M. L. Office in and for  
 State and County aforesaid in Book 44, page 171.
