Lawrence C. Ashmore, his heirs and assigns, all
 that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situated
 in the State and County aforesaid on Reedy River
 about one mile below Conestee Mills, and being lot
 No. 4 in the division of Jacob Landerman's Estate, and
 more fully described by a plat made by J. D. Threl-
 keld on 14th January 1876, and running the following
 metes and bounds: Beginning at a Red Oak, dead,
 3 x 6m, on the west bank of Reedy River, and running
 thence S. 30° 1/2 W. 23.87 chains to a rock 3 x 3 x 6m., thence
 S. 52 1/4 E. 21.50 to rock 3 x 3 x 6m., 8 links from Nickong
