Walter Rainey, et al., and G. W.
Copeland, Trustees of the
School District of
and certain pieces of land situated
lying and being in the
Chief Bluff Spring Township near the
Bluff Springs Road,
and adjoining lands to the
southward, and westward
beginning at a stone on R. L. Stock's
line, then thad westward and southward
thence N. 64 E. 44 p. 8 feet to a iron bin on R. L. Stock's
line and line of road; the piece, 1.818 p. 26. 317. 9 feet
to ad iron bin and right of way next Thad Westendorf lands
and myself, theace, will take and leave 7.172 W. 312. 9
feet to the left beginning above and going three-fourths
 $(\frac{3}{4})$
and take more or less in this also to be a part of
this deed that I, the said T. B. Bramlett, agree to
give to the said trustees the
right of way to the above
described lot of land; the right of way to be as
follows: Beginning at a point in the Suncombe Road
which is on the hillside between Thad Westendorf
and myself and following the said line until the
above described lot of land is reached. The said
right of way is not to be over twenty feet wide.
