is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said T. Frank R. Hunt, his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate, to wit: All that lot of situate lying and being in Ward One of City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid and known as lot number 8 of the A. F. Ferguson property according to plan of same recorded in the Office of Register of Deeds Conveyance for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book C at page 354. Beginning at corner of lots 7 and 8 on Milton Street at distance of 415 feet from the intersecting of Milton Street and at fourteen foot alley, and running thence N. 13° 30' E. 57 $\frac{1}{4}$  feet to corner off lots 8 and 9 on said Milton Street, thence N. 76° 30' W. 150 feet to a point on rear line of lot no. 18, thence S. 13° 30' W. 57 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet to a point on rear line of lot number 16; thence S. 76° 30' E. 150 feet to the beginning, and being the same conveyed to me by C. Dunford, Master by his deed dated April 25th, 1917 and recorded in the R.M.C. office for Greenville County, Book 9, at page 161. As a part of the consideration of this deed of conveyance, the grantee herein agreed to assume and pay all mortgage given by the grantor to Walter M. Scott, Probate Judge for Greenville County. The said mortgage is dated April 5th, 1917 amount \$100.00 and recorded in Book 60 at page 233.
