KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

James Young of Greenville

in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of

at and before the sealing of these presents by *Ascanard Young, (my wife) of the*
County and State aforesaid,

(the receipt whereof

is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

Ascanard Young, and her heirs and assigns, the following described Real estate, to wit:

First: all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, and County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, on Mountain Creek and Reservoir Roads, and having the following lines and corners;

Beginning at a rock on the Reservoir Road, and running thence N. 85 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 14.25 chains to sycamore 3X, thence S. 37 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 15.16 chains to stone 3X out, thence S. 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 12.78 to persimmon, thence S. 20. E. 1.95 to corner of Mountain Creek Road; thence with said road N. 33 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 2.90 to bend in road thence N. 73 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 6.50 to intersection of Reservoir Road, beginning E. 10.32 to bend; thence N. 26 E. 5.13 to bend, thence N. 5 $\frac{1}{4}$ E. 5.00 to the beginning corner, containing thirty-three (33) acres of wood.

Second: all that other certain pieces, parcels or tract of land situate, lying and being in the same State, County and Township and having the following lines and corners, to wit:

Beginning at a stake on a branch on the line of King and Green, and running thence due E. 196 feet to a stump 3X0; thence N. 29.33 E. 6.224 feet to a stake on Road, thence across said road N. 28.45 W. 88 feet to a stake on branch, thence up the branch to the beginning corner, containing eight-tenths (8/10) acre, more or less, these being the last two parcels of land conveyed to me by A. W. Green by deed dated Sept. 11th, 1914, and recorded in the R. R. C. Office for said County and State in Volume #26 of deeds, at page 453, to which reference is hereby made.
