by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said

W. O. Hobbs, All that certain lot of land situate, in the First Ward of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit, Beginning at a point on the north side of West North Street twenty-four (24) feet east of the northeast corner of North and Laurens Streets being the corner of Mile Blatty Company and running thence with line of said Mile Blatty Company, in a northerly direction forty-eight (48) feet or more to Thornton's line, thence with Thornton's line and an easterly direction parallel with North Street forty-eight (48) feet, thence in southerly direction parallel with Laurens Street forty-eight (48) feet or more to North Street, thence with North Street in a westerly direction forty-eight (48) feet to the beginning corner, being composed of two lots conveyable together two acres, one from Charlotte P.
