 to me, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by R. D. Chapman of Greenville, S. C. (the receipt whereof is here-
 by acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Relented, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Relent, unto the said

R. D. Chapman, all that certain piece parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being
 near the City Limits of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid and
 being a part of the subdivision known as City View, and beginning at a stake on
 Henderson Street, one hundred fifty (50) feet North of Canal Street and running
 thence in an Easterly direction One Hundred and fifty (150) feet to a stake on a ten foot
 alley, thence with said Alley in a Northerly direction fifty (50) feet to a stake column
 of Lot No. 41, thence up a Northerly direction with line of Lot No. 44 one hundred
 fifty (50) feet to a stake on Henderson Street, thence and Northerly direction in
