## COURT OF COMMON PLEAS.

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

I, E. Jurnan

Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Sallie J. Simpson, Minnie S. Cooley, Lillian Benson,  
Shuman Simpson, Louis Simpson, Johnnie S. Wood, Guy  
Simpson, W. A. Simpson, Lois Simpson and Frances Simpson,  
the four last named by W. C. Cooley, their guardian ad litem

on or about the 1st day of July in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and fifteen exhibited their  
complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against H. P. Mc Gee as Trustee

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 3rd day of 3rd July 1916, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinabove mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Jurnan  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to H. P. Mc Gee, as Trustee  
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. 6058)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Jurnan  
Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,  
HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

H. P. Mc Gee, as Trustee,  
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying  
and being in Greenville County, Oaklawn Township stated  
aforesaid, and containing Nineteen acres, more or less and  
having the following bounds and metes: Beginning on the  
Grove Station Road between Pelzer and Grove Station at a stone  
3x, thence 52 E 9' to a stone 3x; thence S. 64 W. 12.25 to a stone 3x;  
thence up the Grove Road to the beginning corner. The  
above contains three and one-half acre, sold by E. L. Bea-  
gle to Smith. This tract was formerly conveyed to C. C. Wilson  
by W. A. Simpson and to the latter by J. A. Morris by deed dated  
Dec. 1, 1906. Also that other piece, parcel or lot of land situate, ly-  
ing and being in Greenville County, adjoining the above on  
the East side of the Pelzer Road and containing three and  
one-half acre, more or less; Beginning on the Grove Road at  
Mrs. B. J. Owen's corner, thence with Mrs. Owen's line 6.50 S 30 E 700  
to a pine; thence N. 2.50 E 45 W. 700 ft. to the corner of the public  
road 2.50 E 45' to the beginning corner. These two lots are  
the same but separate lots Deeded to C. C. Wilson by J. A. Dindly.  
The same will show on record at Greenville, York County.

Also all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land known as  
Lot No. 3, lying on the East side of the Grove Road and being  
a part of the tract of land belonging to the late husband of  
G. W. Alderson, consigned to her estate by his last will and  
testament, which was duly probated at Anderson County, South  
Carolina, the said lot containing three-fourths of an acre, more or less.  
Beginning at a stone on the Grove and Greenville Road, on  
Nose Creek corner, thence N. 52 1/2 east 200, thence N. 37 3/4 west 350,  
thence S. 52 1/2 west 23, thence 54 1/2 E 352 to the beginning corner.  
The above described tracts of land were all conveyed to W. A.  
Simpson by C. C. Wilson by deed dated February 19, 1912, recorded  
March 18, 1912, in R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 19 at  
page 26.

Also all that certain lot of land, situated in the County  
and State aforesaid, near the Eastern limits of the City of  
Greenville, and known as lot #40, Block A, of Jefferson Heights,

as shown by plat of record in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, and having the following metes  
and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a pin on Second Avenue,  
point corner of lot #37 and running thence S. 81 40' W. 87 feet,  
5 inches to a pine; thence S. 0-30 W. 25 feet, 5 inches to a pine,  
thence N. 81 40' E. 87 feet, 5 inches to a pine on Second Avenue  
thence with said Avenue, N. 0-30 E. 25 feet, 5 inches to begin-  
ning corner. See Vol. 23, page 47, in record office for Greenville  
County.

appertaining; and all the estate, right, title, claim and interest whatsoever, of the parties to the cause aforesaid, and of each of them in and to the same;  
and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by any of them.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said  
H. P. Mc Gee, as Trustee, his successor, heirs and assigns forever.
