WHEREAS, Ralph Johnson

on or about the 5<sup>th</sup> day of May in the year of  
our Lord nineteen hundred and Seventeen exhibited This complaint in the Court  
of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Willie T. Thompson, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1917, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. J. Imman, Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Mary K. MacNeill for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. \_\_\_\_\_).

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. J. Imman, Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred Sixty (760.00) Dollars, HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

Mary K. MacNeill, the following described real estate, to-wit:-

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the city of Greenville, South Carolina, on the south west corner of Stone Avenue and Rowley Street, and described as follows:

Beginning at the corner of Stone Avenue and Rowley Street and running thence with Stone Avenue S. 41-50 E. 55 feet to a stake on Stone Avenue, thence S. 20-19 W. 34 1/2 feet to a stake; thence N. 71-50 W. 55 feet to a stake on Rowley Street; thence with Rowley Street N. 20-19 E. 37 1/2 feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot conveyed to the plaintiff and the defendants by W. A. Chandler on August 13<sup>th</sup>, 1907. Deed recorded in Office of Clerk for Greenville County, in Vol. VVV, page 1137."
