Conrad T. Griffin and E.C. Griffin

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto  
the said Conrad T. Griffin and E.C. Griffin, all that certain piece, part  
or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid,  
and, or Saluda River and containing Fifty-five and ninety-seven  
one hundredths (55.97) acres more or less. Said tract of land is a portion  
of the tract conveyed to me by Mrs. Frances Jane Whitmire on February  
11<sup>th</sup>, 1894, by deed recorded in Vol. A.D.A. page 470, R.M.C. Office for Greenville  
County. Said tract of land has the following metes and bounds as shown upon  
a plat of survey made by W. A. Hester, Surveyor, November 20<sup>th</sup> 1916; Beginning  
at a stake near the Spring at a corner of J. G. Farr's line and running  
thence N. 19° 2' - W. 8.00 to a Stake nm; thence N. 48° 4' - W. 14.50 to a Dogwood  
tree; thence S. 80° 4' - W. 3.50 to a Stake nm; thence N. 77° W. 1.75 to a Stake near  
another Spring; thence down the Spring Branch 11.38 to a Stake in said  
Branch; thence N. 81° 4' W. to a Red Oak tree, was a Stake near the River Bank.  
thence down the meanders of Saluda River 46.00 ch. to a Stake near  
the River Bank; thence N. 38° 4' - E. 7.10 to a Stone nm; thence N. 34° 1/2' - E.  
1.5 to a Pinonion Tree 13 nm; thence N. 50° - E. 2.20 to a Pinonion  
tree; thence N. 39° 1/2' - E. 4.70 to a Stake; thence S. 38° 1/2' - E. 4.41 to a Cedar on
