(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said Pearle Ligon, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate lying and being in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, same being an portion of Boyce's Addition to Greenville, located in Ward 2 and having the following metes and bounds according to a plat thereof now recorded in the office of R. M. C. for Greenville County in plat book "A" at page 179 to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on east side of Boyce Avenue; 176 feet from the corner of Washington Road and running thence N. 76° 45' E. 205 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 15° 25' E. 28.8 feet to an iron pin on E. & W. Williams and his heirs, executors and administrators, one half interest in all that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, bounded by lands of Mrs. Lou Pooser & Fred Nancy Stewart, Nancy Smith, Charles Holiday, H.
