a part of a lot of land situated ate - lying and being in the
State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, "O'Neal Jacksonville," on the east side
of Sardis Creek, on the south side of the old
Wayside Bridge Road and lying lands of C. H. Wallengren and
Mrs. Groce, and having to the north boundary and bounded on the west
