NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, L. O. Lathem in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS, to me, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by C. Q. West.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said C. Q. West his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain tract of land containing 25 acres more or less in Greenville, State and County aforesaid, and on the Spartanburg Road, about 2 miles E. of Greenville Court House. The said tract being composed of 2 tracts Nos. 7 and 8 according to plat dated Aug 8th 1911, hereafter to be recorded, and is described by miles and bounds as follows: Beginning on S. side of Spartanburg Road, cor. of lot 2106 (A. A. Green land), thence, with the exception of 0.816.6 ft. to pine on Spartanburg Road at cor. of W.C.L. & L. Col. land, thence S. 37° 15' E. 848 ft. to a pine across a branch, thence S. 21° 07' N. 303 ft. and 6 in. to pine, thence S. 72° 15' W. 286 ft. to A. A. Green col. thence with license line N. 35° 45' W. 1877 ft. to beginning cor. on Spartanburg Road. This is a part of that tract of land conveyed to me by R. C.
