All that piece, parcel and tract of land situate in the State and County aforesaid and in Austin Township, containing twenty-eight acres, more or less, and beginning at a point stamp 37 and running thence S. 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 28.00 to a stone 320 m., thence S. 70 E. 18.00 to a stone on Stoney Creek, thence up Stoney Creek, the creek the line, to a stone in said Creek 379 m., thence S. 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 12.50 to a stone 320 m., thence S. 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 12.00 to the beginning corner and bounded by lands of G.
