NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. C. Gaines, of Richland County, and in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty (\$450.00) DOLLARS, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. E. Burdew

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. E. Burdew and his heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Boundary and Monaghan Roads now known as Augusta Street, near the Monaghan Mills and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

Beginning at a stake on the corner of said lot being also the Monaghan Mill Line; on the East side of said Road and running thence with said road S. 13° 34' W. 60 feet to a stake corner; thence with line of lot #2, S. 84° E. 100 feet to a stake, thence N. 13° 34' E. 60 feet to a stake at line of Monaghan Mill Property; thence with Monaghan Mill Line N. 84° W. 100 feet to the beginning corner; this being the square lot of land conveyed to me by F. "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on Augusta Street in Ward six of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at the iron pipe on curbing of Augusta Street, corner of J. C.
