 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *J. W. Lockaby* of the County of
Greenville and *J. W. Lockaby* of the County of *Greenville*, in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of *Five Hundred* DOLLARS,
 to *me* in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *G. W. Bishop*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *G. W. Bishop*, all my right, title and undivided one-half interest of in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and Greenville County, Bates Township, having the following metes and bounds: Beginning on a white oak 3x5 stone, thence S. 75° 2' W. 10.15 chs. to a small Hickory, thence S. 24° E. 7.60 chs. to a hickory, thence S. 36° 47' W. 11.00 chs. to a red oak, thence N. 60° 47' W. 0.75 chs. to a poplar; thence S. 30° 47' W. 13.50 chs. to a stone (near a pine); thence down the branch 12.20 chs. to a stone; thence N. 56° 47' E. 7.25 chs. to a stake; thence S. 12° E. 4.75 chs. to a Hickory; thence N. 16° E. 9.75 chs. to a small root or tree; thence N. 20° 14' E. 2.75 chs. to a pine; thence a road 18.80 chs. to the beginning corner, containing fifty-nine (59) acres more or less and bounded by lanes of *Charles Cooper*, Estate of S.S. Crittenden, Henry Gibson and others, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by *H. E. Hart* by a deed bearing date 22nd day of Sept. 1911, and recorded in the R. M. C.
