NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I B. C. Berry, of Greenville County
in consideration of the sum of Eighteen Thousand Dollars,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. M. Briddle

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. M. Briddle all that certain piece of land or tract
of land situate, lying and being in the State and County
aforesaid, and on the south side of Elkhorn's Branch of
Cane Creek, water of Middle Upper Divid, and having the following metes
and boundaries to wit: Beginning at a stake 3x on the road, the 3x
of W. P. Gibson's tract and running thence with Gibson's line
N. 44° 30' E. 20.75 chs. to stake 3x (gone), thence down branch N. 78° 2.28
chs. to stake, thence 3.78 E. 9.25 chs. to stake, thence N. 76 1/4 E
2.80 chs. to stake, thence N. 84.30 E. 2.27 chs. to Hickory 3x
on south side branch 3x of R. T. Howell, thence with his line
S. 67.30, 10.09 chs. to stake 3x, thence 13.30 N. 6.75 chs. to fence
