NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, F. M. Hudgens and James T. Hudgens, of the County of Greenville, and in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars and other valuable DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. T. Hudgens,

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. T. Hudgens, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, and being known and designated as Lot # 6 on Plat of Monaghan Annex, recorded in R. M. C. office for said County in Plat Book C, at page 63, containing the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stake on the southeast corner of Smyth Street and Parker Road, and running thence with said Parker Road S. 48 1/4 E. one hundred and fifteen and three-tenths (115.3) feet to a stake, corner of lot # 1; thence with line of lot # 1 in a southerly direction sixteen and four-tenths feet to a stake, corner of lot # 5; thence with line of lot # 5 in a northerly direction one hundred and ten (110) feet to a stake on the east side of Smyth Street; thence with Smyth Street N. 10 45 E. twenty-nine and three-tenths (29.3) feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to us on the 8th day of June 1914 by A.
