NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. C. E. Lindsey
in the State aforesaid
in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and ... DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. J. Lindsey & W. F. Lindsey

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
J. J. Lindsey and W. F. Lindsey, a certain tract, piece or parcel of land situated in County
and State aforesaid on branch waters of Middle Tyger River, containing eighty-two acres,
more or less. Beginning on a rock corner near the Old Gate place nearly north of the Road;
thence nearly West to a Oak; thence nearly North to a Poplar on the bank of the Creek;
thence up the Creek to the fork of said creek; thence nearly N.E. to a Oak; thence nearly
North to a rock, corner; thence nearly West to a rock corner; thence nearly North to a rock
corner; thence nearly N.E. to a black-Gum; thence with the old line to the beginning rock
corner, known as the Old Shapley Barton Place.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said
J. J. Lindsey & W. F. Lindsey, their heirs and assigns, forever.
AND I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said J. J. Lindsey & W. F. Lindsey
their heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
