DEED TO B. M. & Janie Cooper

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That S. R. Kelley of the County of Greenville and in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred and Two Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by B. M. Cooper and Janie Cooper, both of the County and State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said B. M. Cooper and Janie Cooper, their heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, near Brandon mill, known as lot No. 114 in Block "A", on plat of the lands of Melville Land Company, recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds for said County in Plat Book "A" Page 99, fronting on Fraction Street fifty and  $\frac{1}{2}$  feet and shading a depth of one hundred and fifty feet on one side and one hundred and forty nine feet on the other side and having a three room dwelling house thereon and being the same lot of land conveyed to me (S. R. Kelley) by Mrs. Lula G. Triplett by deed bearing September 30<sup>th</sup>, 1914, and recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds for said County in Deed Book, Vol. 46, Page 450.
