NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Martha E. Rochester of Greenville County and Iola Forest in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of Two thousand \$2,000.00 DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by F. M. Pike of the State + County aforesaid

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said F. M. Pike his heirs and assigns all of that certain piece, parcel and lot of land, situated in the State and County aforesaid being the remainder of the home tract of land conveyed to me by F. M. Pike containing seventy three and $\frac{13}{100}$ acres, less forty three sold by F. M. Pike to Homer Hamby and bounded by lands of Winifield Smith, Homer Hamby and others, also all of that other tract of land situated in the State and County aforesaid, being the same tract of land conveyed to F. M. Pike by J. H. Stephens adjoining lands of J. H. Stephens Iola Forest and others and having the following meters and bounds: Beginning at iron pin in middle of road, thence $S 62\frac{1}{2} W 22.00$ to stone thence $S 63\frac{1}{2} E 10.17$ to stake, thence $N 36\frac{1}{2} E 18.60$ to beginning containing more and $\frac{3}{5}$ acres more or less also the following lot of land adjoining the above. Beginning on an iron pin on old line thence $S 21\frac{1}{2} E 6.88$ to iron pin thence $S 55\frac{1}{2} W 4.70$ to road, in middle of road, thence with said road $N 6\frac{1}{2} E 3.68$ to road, thence $N 12\frac{1}{2} W 4.50$ to beginning containing one and $\frac{3}{5}$ acres more or less. Mar. Iola Forest my mother having a life interest in this land described above and this same land along with me to F. M. Pike his heirs and assigns forever

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said F. M. Pike his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we do hereby bind ourselves + ours heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said F. M. Pike his

heirs and assigns, against us and ours heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
