 NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *I, Allen J. Sullivan of Greenville* in the State aforesaid
 in consideration of the sum of *Three Thousand Five Hundred* DOLLARS,
 to *me* in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *J. B. Brown*
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said
J. B. Brown his heirs and assigns: All that certain
 piece, parcel and tract of land situate, lying and
 being in Austin Township, County and State aforesaid
 having the following boundaries: Bounded
 by lands of *J. D. Burdett, Chas. Hahn, Rich*
Darson and others; with metes and bounds
 as follows: beginning at a stone on road near
 Residence on said land and running thence
 N. 83 E. 33.60 to a stone 37; thence N. 43 W. 17.50
 to a stone 37; thence S. 83 W. 29.20 to a stone
 37; thence S. 43 W. 17.50 to the beginning corner,
 containing fifty-four (54) acres more or less,
 and being the same tract of land conveyed
 to me by Ernest J. Brown by deed dated
 Jan. 12, 1912.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
 TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said *J. B. Brown, his*
 heirs and assigns, forever.

AND *I* do hereby bind *myself + my* heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and
 forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said *J. B. Brown, his*
 heirs and assigns, against *me* and *my* heirs, and against
 every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
