in consideration of the sum of Seven Thousand (\$7,000.00) DOLLARS,
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Sarah H. Garrison

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Sarah H. Garrison, all that piece, parcel, and lot of land, situate on the East side of Rutherford Street, in the city and County of Greenville, and State aforesaid, beginning at an iron pin on the North side of Bull's Alley, and running thence with Bull's Alley S. 29° E two hundred and fifty (250) feet to an iron pin; thence with fence N. 2 W. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 89° W. two hundred and fifty (250) feet to an iron pin on Rutherford Street; thence with Rutherford Street S. 2. E. seventy-one (71) feet to the beginning, containing 17, 625 square feet, more or less, being the same lot of land conveyed to M. S. Mitchell by Lee Greene, by deed dated Oct. 3rd 1905, and recorded in the Office of R. M. Co. for Greenville County, in Vol. A. K. L. at page 180, and conveyed to P. E. Gear by the said M. S.
